"This week we look at Envy and it's opposite Gratitude.

The theological definition of envy is resentment or sadness at another's good fortune or excellence, with an often insatiable desire to have it for oneself. Envy is more than simple jealousy as it includes the belief that another's excellence or blessings lessens one's own, and it makes one want to destroy another's good fortune. It can be countered with the heavenly virtue of gratitude through which we realise that every aspect of our existence is a gift from God. St. Thomas Aquinas explained that "gratitude is giving a just response of thanks in words and actions to those who benefit us." "
